Montana BMW Riders has reserved ONE day this year for the club's 2013 MSF Advanced Rider Course, which will once again be held at the range in Helena. The dates is Saturday, May 4. This date is reserved for club members first, so save the date and sign up soon! We filled two days last year and members learned a great deal – at the end of the day there was a bunch of smiling, hot, tired, happy riders who had their skill base expanded or at least reinforced.

This one-day course complements a rider's basic skills and helps with personal risk assessment. Improving braking and cornering finesse is emphasized. The course is beneficial for riders on any type of street motorcycle.
