Founded in 1987, it serves as the community's primary resource for emergency food and nutritional support. In 2024, the program served over **9,700 individuals** across 4,166 households.

2025 Mileage Contest - Larry Banister

The Montana BMW Riders 2025 mileage contest winners were announced at the Missoula Christmas lunch on December 6th, held at The Den in Missoula.

A great big thanks and congrats to the 24 participants that entered this year, all submitting their final mileage by the contest ending date (10/31/25) and thus all were eligible for awards. As are our contest rules state, there are three "paid" awards given each year, first award for the entrant who accumulated the most miles during the contest period, second award going to the entrant who's total mileage is closest to the average of the miles ridden by all participants, and finally, after eliminating the first two winners, all remaining names are put into a hat and a name drawn for the "at large" winner. I have attached the final spread sheet which shows all of the contestants, each of their mileage accumulations and the average mileage calculation for this year's contest.

Will Parker and **Phil Yasenak** were at the top of the list for this year for most miles accumulated, with Phil edging Will out of first place. For his efforts Phil will be presented with a \$75 check from the club and has his name engraved on this year's mileage contest register. (Photos of the club mileage register are also shown below. This mileage register is on display at Big Sky BMW.) **Dean Hall's** actual mileage was the closest to the average mileage calculated, and he'll receive a check for \$50 from the club. **Janet Webster** was drawn as the "at large" winner and will also receive a check from the club for \$50. Janet's name was drawn at an "official mileage contest meeting at City Brew" by **Sandy Knutsen** in the presence of **Liz Banister**, **Dick French** and **me**.

Thanks again to everyone who participated this year, thanks to the club for its continuing support and finally thanks for the privilege of letting me keep this contest running for another year.

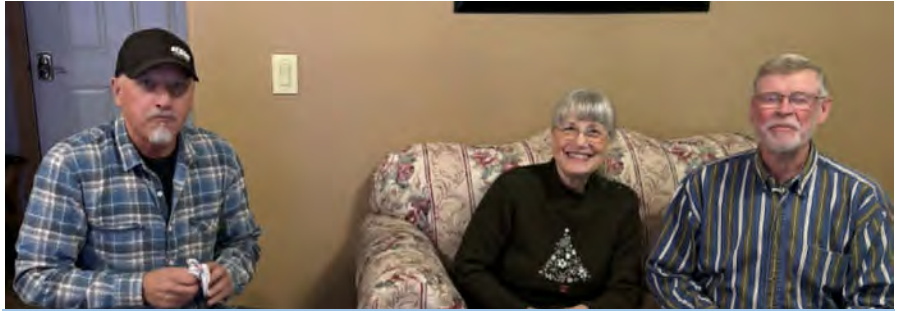

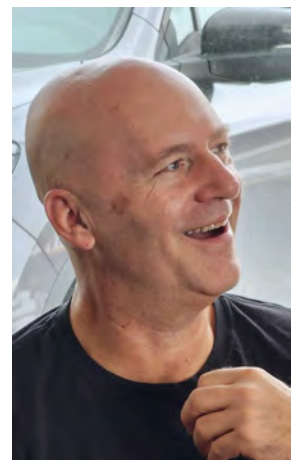

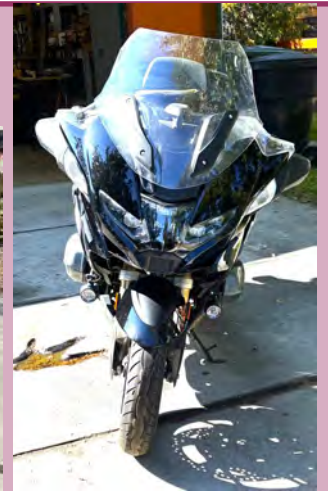

Hi again Richard,

Here's the original photo that I sent to BMW MOA of my 2003 R1200C. The photo was taken on 01 October 2025 at Hyalite Reservoir in the Gallatin Range just south of Bozeman. It was a beautiful fall day and it snowed in the mountains the next day as I recall. I had a R1200C in 2001 or so (same ivory color), and sold it for another BMW, which I then sold for another BMW, which I then sold for another BMW...etc. I've always had fond memories of this bike and, to be honest, the attention it would draw to itself wherever I rode it. I've never had so many compliments for a "cool looking bike" as this one. I found this 2003 R12C in New England for sale by the original owner (my age!) in Dec. 2021 with only 18,554 miles on the odometer. I had it shipped out to Bozeman that winter and then took it to Big Sky Motorsports in Missoula and left it with them for the duration of the winter for a complete overhaul (thank you Andy and Nate!). Everything on the bike is BMW OEM and she is now in pristine, new condition -- she's a real beauty! The bike was in really good condition when I received it from the east coast, but I cleaned or replaced everything that had New England grime/rust on it (I even purchased brand-new wheels from BMW (\$\$\$!) to replace the original ones that were pitted from 20 years of humidity and salt). As most BMW aficionados know, this model and color of BMW was first shown to the world in the James Bond movie "*Tomorrow Never Dies*" in 1997 with Pierce Brosnan and Michelle Yeoh. When I went to the Gallatin County Courthouse in Bozeman to get my Montana license plate, guess what -- the numbers on the plate were 007!!! I tend to not be superstitious or anything, but this was shocking to say the least! Anyway, I love the R12C and keep her in pristine, mint condition - she's my garage queen and I take very good care of her. My other bike is a 2025 BMW R1300GS and my wife rides a Ducati Scrambler. I'm now 75 years old and my goal (our goal) is to keep riding as long as possible!

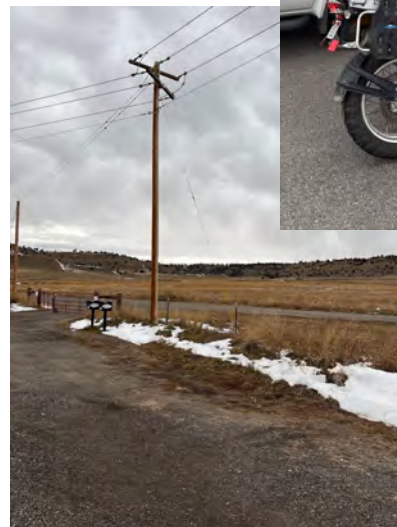

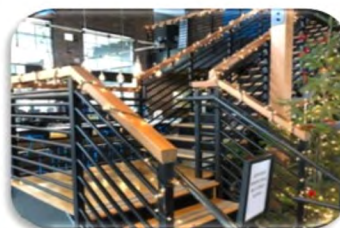
